The Kennel Club urges dog owners in Scotland to respond to dog theft consultation

The proposed Dog Abduction (Scotland) Bill aims to create a new statutory offence to tackle the problem of dog theft, and other situations where a dog is taken or kept without lawful authority. It would take account of considerations such as the feelings of dogs and dog welfare, as well as improving data recording to better inform detection and prevention efforts.

Currently in Scotland, the abduction of a dog is often treated in the same way as the theft of a household commodity such as a mobile phone, due to the unnecessary weighting on the monetary value rather than the emotional impact of the crime.

The Kennel Club has long campaigned on the issue of pet theft, lobbying for sentencing to recognise the emotional value of a dog and for better reporting and recording from officials so that

underlying causes of dog theft can be tackled. The Kennel Club's Paw and Order campaign, which launched during the pandemic, subsequently illustrated the need for reform and spurred thousands of dog lovers to share their views.

"...we wholeheartedly welcome this consultation, which we believe is integral for helping to safeguard the nation's much-loved pets."

Dr Ed Hayes, Head of Public Affairs at The Kennel Club, said: "Dogs are such an important and valued member of the family, and we wholeheartedly welcome this consultation, which we believe is integral for helping to safeguard the nation's much-loved pets."

"Last year, the UK Government announced plans to introduce a specific criminal offence for those who steal dogs across England and Wales, and this proposed Bill is an important opportunity for Scotland to follow suit and make a necessary step forward for dog welfare. Therefore, we urge the public to respond to the consultation to ensure their views and concerns are represented and the safety of dogs in



Scotland is better protected."

Entries must feature a dog, either belonging to the photographer or one they know, and should fit one of three themes:

YOUR EVERYDAY DOG – *your dog captured in its everyday life*

YOUR COMPETING DOG – *your dog captured enjoying competing and hoping to get to Crufts*

YOUR WORKING DOG – *your dog captured working and helping in an environment they love*

This year's judging panel will be looking for photographs that portray one of the themes, whilst also demonstrating creativity. They will look at three key areas: impact of the photograph, creativity of image and how well it demonstrates technical ability.

The Kennel Club urges participation at multi-breed health screening days to help protect dogs

The Kennel Club is urging participation in its upcoming multi-breed health screening days, organised to enable owners and breeders to protect their dog's health and make responsible and informed breeding decisions.

The health screening assessments available are:

- **The Kennel Club and University of Cambridge Respiratory Function Grading Scheme assessment, for Bulldogs, French Bulldogs and Pugs**, to detect BOAS (Brachycephalic Obstructive Airway Syndrome) and provide advice for owners and breeders, carried out by approved assessors. More information about the scheme is available at thekennelclub.org.uk/rfgs

- **The Kennel Club Heart Scheme assessments for Cavalier King Charles Spaniels**, to detect signs of heart murmurs and mitral valve disease and provide advice for breeders, carried out by cardiologists. More information about the scheme is available at thekennelclub.org.uk/heartscheme

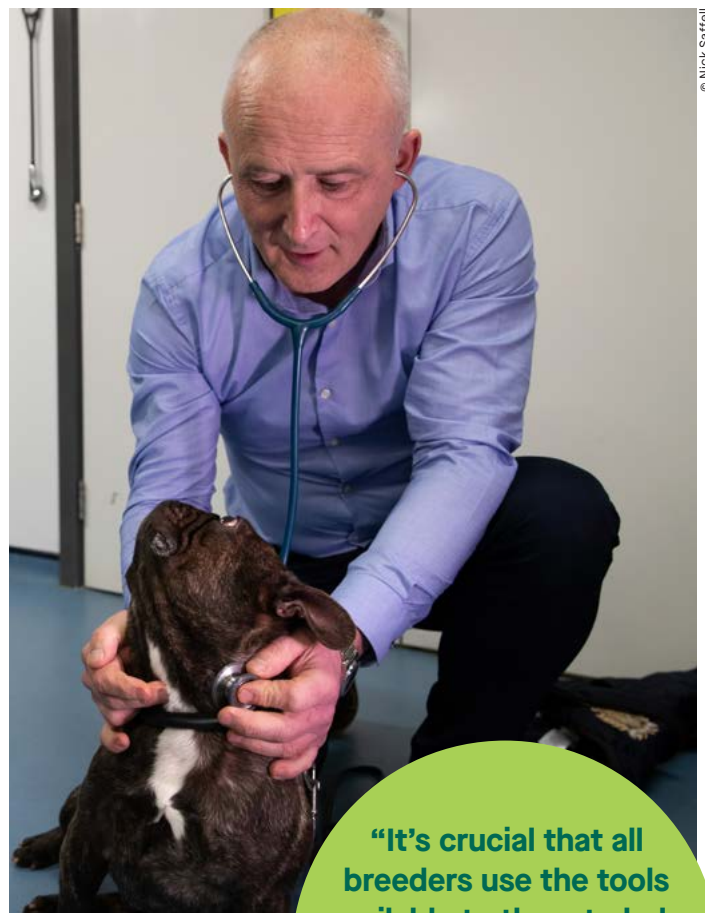

The Kennel Club holds successful Health and Welfare Conference

On Saturday 12 November, The Kennel Club's inaugural Health and Welfare Conference welcomed over 80 attendees to collaborate and discuss significant canine topics.

Bringing together dog health and welfare experts, including scientists and vets, breed club and rescue representatives, owners and breeders, the event took place at Chesford Grange, Kenilworth, and saw talks and interactive Q&A sessions with The Kennel Club's geneticist, Dr Joanna Ilska, who discussed breeding tools for the future, and cardiologist Dr Hannah Stephenson, explaining more about heart health in dogs.

Elsewhere, Breed Health Coordinators met with The Kennel Club health team to discuss Breed Health and Conservation Plans, new research, setting up health surveys, small breed populations and genetic diversity, and Breed Watch, and representatives from The Kennel Club Breed Rescue and the Assured Breeders scheme were on hand to answer queries and offer advice.

Bill Lambert, Health, Welfare and Breeder Services Executive at The Kennel Club opened

the day, and comments: "We were delighted to welcome all those interested in discussing, protecting and improving dog health and welfare at the conference this weekend. Meeting in-person meant there was much discussion among attendees and speakers, and the sessions from our experts were well received and informative. I would like to thank all those who attended the event and continue to do their bit to improve dog health and welfare, and those who organised, presented and contributed to its success.

"We hope to hold another similar event in November 2023 at The Kennel Club in London to continue to find ways to collaborate and make a difference for dogs together."

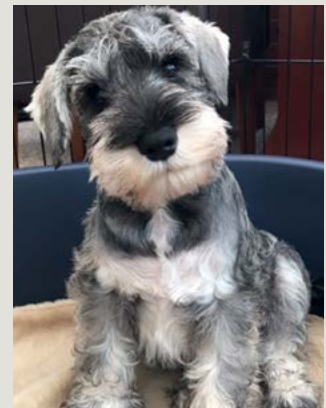

Launch of new Kennel Club strategy

As we approach the end of 2022, we are delighted that The Kennel Club, has achieved what it set out to do this year, steered by invaluable insights from our Members and the dog owning public. Which was to design, develop and launch a new strategic direction for The Kennel Club with an evolved purpose, a clearer focus - underpinned by an approach that will enable it to happen - and to share that with Members, all by the end of the year. Mark Beazley Chief Executive shares more...

It seemed a bit daunting in January when there was so much to do, but we are very pleased to say that using those insights, we have created a new strategic direction one that we have so far shared with over 200 members in face to face and virtual roadshows. Those Members have been supportive about the direction of travel and they have told us face to face that this new direction is an improvement. Built upon the feedback we received from over two thirds of Members, via our survey in May, we have heard a huge range of views about what we do and how we do it. In a nutshell, they told us it was time for change, that health and welfare is key, that we need to offer more support to all involved in our canine activities and our grass roots network and that that we need better communication. Importantly, we heard and we recognise there have been considerable customer service issues in recent years, that need to be addressed before we can effect real change. And finally, our conversations with over 5000 members of the public told us that they were unsure of our role, felt we were too elitist and that probably The Kennel Club was not for them.

We have taken these messages to heart. As part of our strategic direction we have prioritised health and welfare and inclusivity, we are in the middle of a new piece of research talking to those who compete in our canine activities, as well as those who run these events and the people that attend them. This will help us

to understand what we need to do to support them in the way they want us to. We have also have stepped up our communication, both face to face and in our publications.

And to address some of our current customer service issues we have improvements already underway. Our final 'Find A' service, Find a Club, will be bought back in the first quarter of 2023, and we have made significant changes to improve delivery times for key services such as puppy registrations and transfers. We have just introduced a new telephone system that will provide a better service with added functionalities such as a webchat

and a call-back facility. We have been working on a highly successful pilot process improvement project with PMI, continuing to improve our Customer Relationship Management (CRM) processes, whilst also looking at how it can better support The Kennel Club in this new phase of strategic development.

Sharing our new direction

Members who attended the roadshows have already been able to hear about our new purpose and to discuss the proposed way forward with our Chairman, Vice Chairman, Directors, Chief Executive and staff experts. And now, on the brink of a new year, the year we celebrate our 150th anniversary, we are pleased to be able to share with our Kennel Club journal readers our agreed strategy - and the steps that are now needed to bring it to life.

Our new purpose

Firstly, a reminder of our new purpose – **making a positive difference for dogs and their owners**. Not so different from our previous mission statement. Why? Because we want to evolve whilst respecting our heritage, and the essence of our pre-existing mission statement was already in line with our collective vision. This has never been about change for change's sake. But the subtle alterations enabled us to emphasise that the KC is here to make a positive difference, and not just for dogs but for their owners as well. Crucially, this really sets us apart from other dog welfare organisations by celebrating the relationship between dogs and their owners and putting those at both ends of the lead at the core of what we do and why we do it.

To ensure we make a positive difference, the Board debated for quite some time as to where our focus should be and where resources would be best used, as we can't be all things to all dogs. These six strategic aims were designed to reflect our priorities.

Underpinning each of these strategic aims are a group of "enablers", activities and projects that will help us to achieve them.

Our strategic aims:



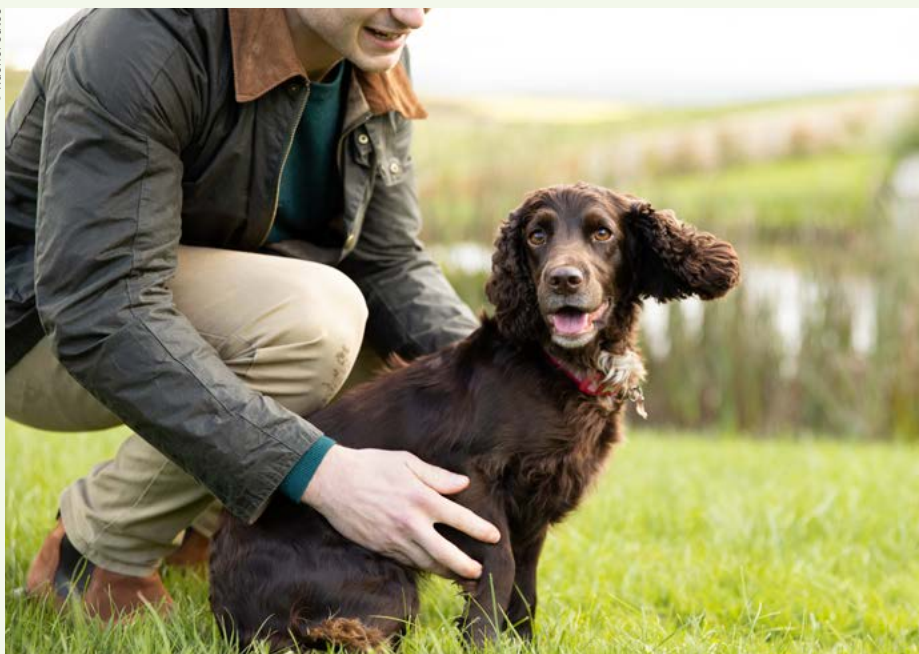
Prioritising customer service

Clearly, we can't do everything all at once, so we're taking a phased approach as there are many links and dependencies between all the things we need to review. Building a future-proofed Kennel Club that achieves our aims and that is more efficient and responsive to our customers' needs, also requires a review of our processes, governance and

systems and this is ongoing work that will underpin everything that we do. Working with Mayvin, an expert agency we are continuing a review of our Governance and Organisational Development. They are experienced in helping organisations understand how they can improve their governance and ways of working so that they are efficient and agile.

Our Members have told us that our current Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system is not providing the level of service they expect for themselves and Kennel Club customers, nor is it currently optimised to support our new strategy. Over the past two years we have been building a comprehensive database supported by a vast pool of knowledge and experience. Once we have a clearer idea of the business process changes we need to make within The Kennel Club, we will be in a position to look at how we can take the existing system to a new level in the future – exploring options for partnerships that have the technical capability to build on what we have, and meet the needs of The Kennel Club for the long term. Having all of these elements in place will give us the strong foundations to provide better levels of customer service, supporting our developed products and services for the next generation of Kennel Club customers.

The change starts now

Safeguard and enhance the future of pedigree dogs, addressing breed-associated health issues

To support *Safeguard and enhance the future of pedigree dogs, addressing breed-associated health issues*, we'll be looking at an assumption we've had for a while – that when owners buy a Kennel Club registered dog, they consider it to be of higher quality be that health, wellbeing or temperament.

We need to ensure we are doing everything we can to deliver on those expectations, to protect the future of The Kennel Club and of pedigree dogs.

We know the world of dogs has changed,

and our registration model needs to reflect that. So we need to work with breeders and potential dog owners to find out how we could evolve our registry to meet their needs. Once this has been addressed, we can close the gap between what people expect from pedigree registration and what can sometimes undermine these assumptions – enabling us to promote pedigree dogs in a way that is clear, confident and consistent. This will, in turn, increase the demand for, and understanding about the unique advantages of pedigree dogs.

Protect the future of dog activities together with our grassroots network

We have already embarked on a governance and organisation development project and are speaking with all our stakeholder groups. Reforming our governance and ways of working are critical to better delivering our new strategic direction by being quicker, more agile and decisive.

And we also know that in partnership we need to strengthen and nurture the important relationships with our grass roots network – and by that we mean our

recognised clubs and societies, organisers of licensed events, dog training instructors and the many other volunteers who give of their time to support these activities.

Early next year we will be looking at the information and insights that come back from our research – where we are talking to those who compete in, run and attend canine activities and events - to understand what our grass roots network need from us and consider how we can meet that need.

Ensure we are financially secure and sustainable

And as we consider the financial implications of supporting our activities, especially those which are not self-funding, we will be considering how we can maximise, prioritise and better use our income and resources, to *ensure we are financially secure and sustainable*.



Deliver an excellent member experience and widen our community

Most importantly we know we need to provide a great membership experience to our current members and look at options for widening our community.

We can be more inclusive, involve different types of people and their dogs, all of which will still protect the essence of pedigree, but gives us a wider community who are ambassadors for what we stand for, who are receptive to and engaged with our messages

and a who will give us louder voice when we're lobbying.

We also know better communication is key and in the last two months we have held six face to face roadshows and two virtual roadshows to share this new strategy in the first instance with members, to hear their feedback, benefit from their support and most importantly, hear their concerns. We now have plans to take this to our wider dog community throughout 2023.

Become relevant to more dog owners to increase our impact

There are several areas we know we need to explore and consider. We know we need to improve our systems - and this work is ongoing. We know we can provide and signpost better dog training options for owners. And we know we have much to do to build awareness of the Kennel Club and the work we do, by the general public.

Champion the wellbeing of dogs

This is a huge area and will be discussed, scoped and optioned in the months ahead.

All work will be undertaken by groups of specialists from within and outside of The Kennel Club. Consisting of Board Directors, staff experts, and external stakeholders, the Design Group findings and all other recommendations will be presented to the Board for agreement before any planning commences. Of course, we will be sharing progress with our stakeholders, members, and the wider dog communities, in a number of different ways; through our publications, face to face virtual meetings and via the dog press.

Clearly, this is a huge amount of work, running alongside current work. But we will ensure that the forward will be realistic, deliverable and considers the feedback received. Only then can The Kennel Club remain recognised, respected and relevant.

So what are people saying?

The Board unanimously agreed the strategic direction, aims and enablers, which given the Directors' range of experience and expertise is a positive voice for the strategy. Members have been vocal in their support; pleased we have

shared it, that their views and voices have been heard.

The Kennel Club staff has given the direction a thumbs up too. Greater clarity, clearer direction and the promise of a solid plan to deliver and measure success have been greeted warmly. As well as the fact that a course correction, is needed in this time of great social, political and financial change. But of course, we have also heard concerns. Members have rightly acknowledged there is a lot to do and the clock is ticking. That more detail is needed now the direction has been

set. And querying how this will all be delivered. All good and valid points. These will be kept in the forefront of our minds as we move forward. Important conversations have already begun and need to continue with care but without delay in the coming weeks and months - by members, by the Kennel Club board and its staff - and we are excited to see the continued positivity, thoughtfulness, determination and collective commitment to driving improvement and change, that we are sure will shine and guide us through.

We will share frequent updates and ask for regular feedback to ensure that our considered approach of moving forward carefully and, understanding what services are really required in today's world, will help us deliver what we have set out to do. **Making a positive difference for dogs and their owners.**

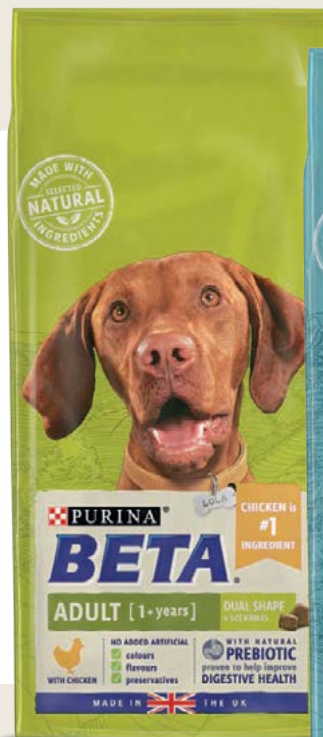
