### Icelandic Sheepdog granted recognition by The Kennel Club

**The Icelandic Sheepdog has been recognised by The Kennel Club with effect from 1 April 2025.**

The breed will be classified in the Pastoral Group on the Imported Breed Register. Until such time as a Kennel Club interim breed standard has been published, the Icelandic Sheepdog is not eligible to compete at Kennel Club licensed breed shows.

The Icelandic Sheepdog is an ancient dog, having been referred to in the Icelandic Sagas

more than a thousand years ago. They are described as an attractive Spitz breed; most intelligent and exceptionally friendly. In addition to its main task of a drover dog as well as a general farm guard and alert dog, the Icelandic Sheepdog has also been used for rounding up the Icelandic horse.

From April 2025, The Kennel Club will recognise 224 breeds of pedigree dog. The last breed to be recognised was the Polish Hunting Dog in April 2024.

## Update on the Regional Support Network

Following the announcement of the new Regional Support Network initiative, The Kennel Club has established six regions, each with a dedicated regional advisor who will provide tailored guidance and resources, making it easier for organisers to access the support they need.

The regions are outlined below, and a complete team has now been recruited, set to be fully operational by early 2025:

- North East and Scotland;
- North West, Ireland, and Isle of Man;
- East of England;
- Midlands and Wales;
- South East;
- South West.

The Regional Support Network marks a substantial enhancement in how The Kennel Club supports shows and societies in delivering events at the local level. With the introduction of these advisors, The Kennel Club will phase out the Field Officer role.

Helen Kerfoot, Chief Canine Health, Activities and Events Officer at The Kennel Club, commented: "We are very excited to have our Regional Support Network advisors in place. This initiative

allows us to adopt a more supportive role with clubs and societies, rather than just focusing on compliance and enforcement.

"We understand the need for more support from The Kennel Club for the grassroots community who play a pivotal role in the world of dogs. We hope this system will streamline our services, making them more efficient, effective and accessible. It will strengthen our relationship with the valued volunteers in canine clubs and societies and enable us to provide a more personalised and locally-based service.

"We are deeply grateful to the Field Officers for their support and assistance to the clubs. Last year alone,

they carried out 254 visits across the UK, which represents 7.5% of shows held, many of which received excellent reviews. We believe that the introduction of the Regional Support Network advisors will help demonstrate The Kennel Club's commitment to working collaboratively with show organisers, focusing on support rather than compliance and enforcement."

The advisors will be reaching out to clubs and societies in their respective areas early in the new year to learn more about how they can provide the best support and information will be available on The Kennel Club website in due course.

# Digitalisation programme launched for smoother, greener service

The Kennel Club is taking steps towards sustainability by exploring digital transformation opportunities. Two areas which have been primarily identified whereby digital certificates could replace hard copies are award and export certificates where not only would the transition reduce paper usage, but also enhance efficiency and convenience for Kennel Club customers.

Traditionally, The Kennel Club has sent award certificates in paper format to exhibitors and competitors post event, this format will still be available for those that prefer on request, but from shows taking place after 1 January 2025 and field trials events taking place after 2 February 2025, exhibitors will be sent a digital copy of their award which they can either download and print or keep on file.

Export certificates will also be sent digitally from the 6 January 2025 which will streamline the process making it much more convenient for both breeder and new puppy owner as there will no longer be a wait for the physical documents to arrive. Subject to meeting all requirements customers could have the certificate in their inbox quicker, allowing for overseas Kennel Club registration. Customers will also be able to order printed copies of an export certificate at an additional cost which will include overseas postage and packaging.

The 'green and white' challenge certificates that exhibitors receive at shows when winning the award will still be provided by The Kennel Club in the usual format at the event. However, going forward the certificates that have traditionally followed for awards such as; Stud Book numbers, Junior Warrants, Show Certificates of Excellence, Veteran Warrants, Open Show awards and agility certificates will from shows taking

place after 1 January be sent digitally and for field trials taking place after 2 February. Customers are reminded that we are now at September on awards certificates so it will be a few months before these arrive in inboxes.

Said Eugene Henney, Membership Services and Property

Executive; "With nearly 30,000 award certificates printed and posted annually and 2000 export certificates, this initiative will significantly reduce paper consumption and the associated environmental impact.

Additionally, it will enhance our service, allowing customers

to receive their documentation more efficiently and of course also eliminating any potential postal delays.

"Like many businesses, The Kennel Club recognises the need to become more sustainable and is actively exploring ways to achieve this in the coming years. In the first instance we hope that by going digital with our awards and export certificates this will contribute to our sustainability goals. While we are committed to reducing our environmental impact, we want to reassure exhibitors that we still offer the option to print hard copies of certificates for those that would prefer them in this format."

# New DNA testing scheme for Rhodesian Ridgebacks

The Kennel Club has approved a new official DNA testing scheme for **degenerative myelopathy (DM)** in the Rhodesian Ridgeback, following consultation with the breed's health co-ordinator on behalf of the breed.

**D**egenerative myelopathy is a progressive neurological disease that causes a range of symptoms and often leads to euthanasia due to poor quality of life.

The disease is believed to be an autosomal-recessive condition. This means that dogs that inherit two copies of the DM gene mutation (one from its mother and one from its father) will have an increased risk of developing the condition.

This disease is not fully understood, and it is believed that environmental factors or other genetic influences can also contribute to whether a dog becomes affected. Having other factors that influence whether or not a dog is affected by this condition means that having two copies of the recessive mutant gene does not necessarily result in clinical disease and similarly, an absence of the gene is not a guarantee that the condition will not occur.

**Tested dogs will be recorded on the Kennel Club systems as either:**

### CLEAR

The dog does not have any copies of the abnormal gene associated with the disease. The dog is at the lowest risk of being clinically affected and will only pass on a normal copy of the gene to a puppy.

### CARRIER

The dog has one copy of the normal gene and one copy of the abnormal gene associated with the disease. The dog is unlikely to be clinically affected, but is at a slightly increased risk, and may pass one copy of the normal gene, or one copy of the abnormal gene on to a puppy.

### AFFECTED

The dog has two copies of the abnormal gene associated with the disease. The dog will be at a higher risk of being clinically affected by the disorder and will pass one copy of the abnormal gene on to any potential offspring.

Test results will be added to the dog's registration details which will trigger the publication of the result in the next available Breed Records Supplement and also on the Health Test Results Finder on the Kennel Club website.

Results for dogs already tested can also be recorded, but owners will need to submit copies of the DNA certificates themselves. DNA test certificates should be scanned and emailed to [health.results@thekennelclub.org.uk](mailto:health.results@thekennelclub.org.uk).

More information about DNA testing is available via a webinar, delivered by The Kennel Club's geneticist, Dr Joanna Illska "**The Science of DNA Testing**".

### Owners are reminded that:

- From August 2018, it is mandatory that the dog's microchip (or tattoo) is recorded along with either the dog's registered name or registered number on any DNA certificates. Any test results issued after that date that do not carry these identifying features will not be accepted.
- The Kennel Club has a set of

criteria that we request DNA testing laboratories to meet to enable us to record their results, helping to maintain and protect the integrity of results that appear on a dog's records. We have updated the list of laboratories that we accept results from and strongly

advise that customers ensure their chosen laboratory is included

on our revised list if they wish The Kennel Club to record and publish the results. Results from laboratories not included on this list will not be recorded.

To find out which

laboratories The Kennel Club is able to record results from, and which laboratories will send results directly to The Kennel Club, please refer to our **website**. To find out which DNA tests are relevant to your breed, visit [thekennelclub.org.uk/breeds](http://thekennelclub.org.uk/breeds).

The Kennel Club constantly reviews DNA testing schemes in conjunction with breed clubs to ensure that breeders are supported with resources which help them to make responsible breeding decisions. The Kennel Club works alongside breed clubs and breed health coordinators in a collaborative effort to improve the health of pedigree dogs and is happy to consider a club's request to add a new DNA test to its lists. A formal request from the breed's health coordinator or a majority request from the breed clubs is normally required to do this.

# The future of the provision of training for dog training instructors

Following a comprehensive review of The Kennel Club Accredited Instructor scheme (KCAI), The Kennel Club has gained valuable feedback from its members through questionnaires and focus groups.

While the KCAI scheme has proven valuable, the review identified opportunities to enhance instructing standards to better serve the wider dog training community. Consequently, the current KCAI scheme will close in its current format by September 2025 for members who have not achieved accreditation.

The closure of the scheme for new accreditations is part of The Kennel Club's ongoing work to overhaul its dog training programme, aiming to improve standards across a broader range and ensure consistency and compliance. Accredited KCAI members who are currently active will remain part of the network and retain their qualifications, provided they stay up to date with their Continuing Professional Development (CPD). Members working towards accreditation who have completed any

of the online modules before 15 January 2025 will be given the opportunity to complete their accreditation within a set timeframe, subject to meeting the required accreditation criteria. Those members who have not completed any online modules by this date will retain their annual membership until their subscription expires.

Helen Kerfoot, Chief Canine Health, Activities and Events Officer, commented: "The Kennel Club is deeply committed to providing the best training through our network of Kennel Club Accredited Instructors and dog training clubs.

"Our objective is to support these instructors and enhance their skills and knowledge, ensuring they maintain high standards and provide good quality training for dog

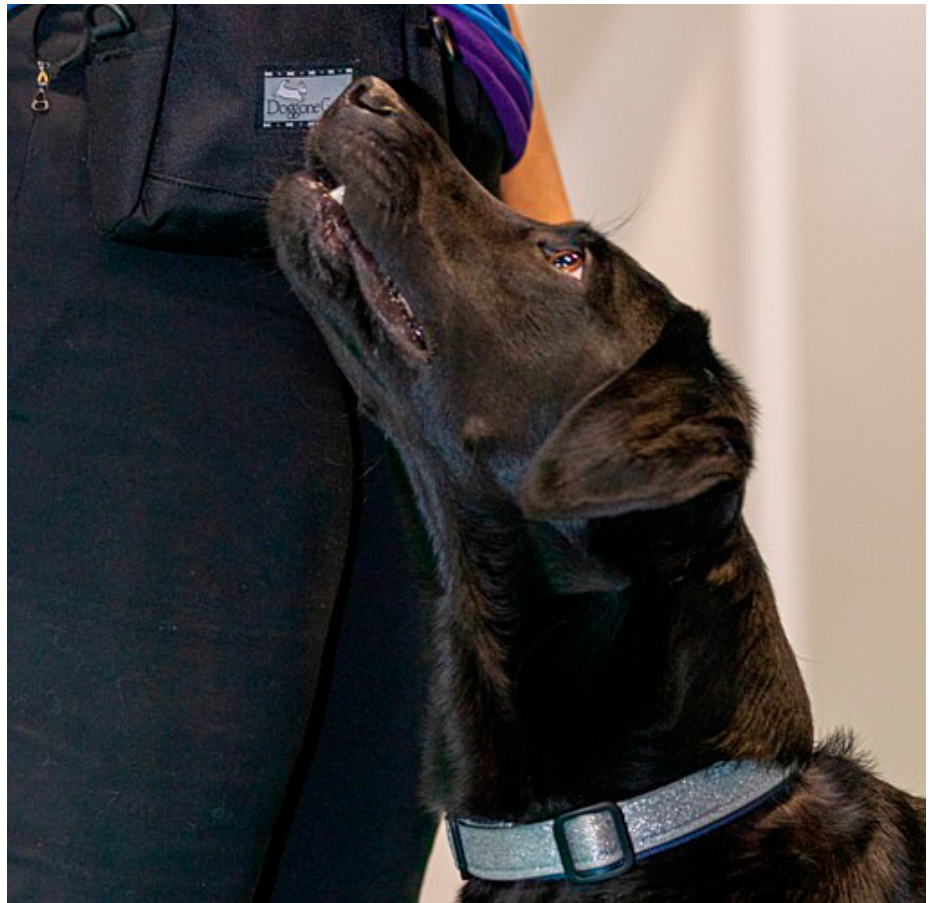
owners. Dog training and its provision by instructors is something that The Kennel Club remains strongly committed to.

"We greatly value the commitment and dedication of our current KCAI scheme members. We know that within the scheme our members are strongly committed to their work, and we look forward to working closely with them in the future."

The Kennel Club continues to hold valuable discussions with Defra and other UK administrations to help safeguard and maintain high standards in the dog training industry.

The decision, although difficult, has been made to ensure its services provide a clear standard for both instructors and dog training clubs to support dog owners.

# German Wirehaired Pointer from County Galway wins Kennel Club Hunt, Point and Retrieve Championship 2024

Ardgroom Artemis, an eight-year-old German Wirehaired Pointer from County Galway in Ireland, has won The Kennel Club's Hunt, Point and Retrieve (HPR) Championship.

The Championship was held on Monday 18 and Tuesday 19 November 2024 at Facombe Estate in Hampshire, and was sponsored by Skinner's Field & Trial Pet Foods, Sporting Saint Gundog Equipment Suppliers and the British Association for Shooting and Conservation (BASC).

Emily has been a member of the Brigg Muttley Crew flyball team since 2018, and last year also competed as part of the YKC Flyball team at Crufts, where she proved to be an inspirational role model to the younger members of the team. She was also recognised for her time and perseverance with training her rescue Border Collie, Dolly, to go on to successfully compete with her.

## Russian Toy to be transferred to breed register

The Kennel Club has announced that the Russian Toy will transfer from the Imported Breed Register to the Breed Register with effect from 1 April 2025.

The breed was recognised by The Kennel Club in 2017 and classified in the Toy group. An interim breed standard was published in 2018 allowing the

breed to be exhibited in Imported Breed Register classes. From April of this year, the Russian Toy will be eligible for separate breed classes.

# KC File for January

## RECOGNITION OF NEW BREED

### ICELANDIC SHEEPDOG

At its recent meeting, the Board granted recognition of the Icelandic Sheepdog on the Imported Breed Register, classified in the Pastoral Group. This is with effect from 1 April 2025. Until such time as a Kennel Club interim breed standard has been published, the breed is not eligible to compete at Kennel Club licensed breed shows.

## TRANSFER OF BREED

At its recent meeting, the Board approved the transfer of Russian Toy from the Imported Breed Register to the Breed Register with effect from 1 April 2025.

## DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

**31 October 2024**  
**Kennel Club Rule A12**  
**Miss Kimberley Barton**

The Committee having carefully considered the conviction of Miss Kimberley Barton of Swindon for the breeding of dogs, without the authority of a licence for that purpose contrary to the Animal

Welfare Act 2006 from the Swindon Magistrates' Court on 30 June 2023.

The Committee impose the following penalties:

1. To disqualify her from exhibiting at, taking part in, attending and/or having any connection with any event licensed by the Club. If any person disqualified under this sub-paragraph shall attend any canine event whilst disqualified the Board shall have the power to increase the period of disqualification [A11 j (4)]
2. To disqualify her from effecting registrations of any or all dogs and/or progeny of such dogs which are owned and/or registered by her (whether or not jointly owned and/or whether or not owned and/or registered in the name of a nominee) [A11 j (9)]

The suspensions and disqualifications are to be from 31 October 2024 until 29 June 2025.

The Committee noted a disqualification from dealing in dogs for two years was imposed by the Magistrates Court. There was an appeal against the conviction but the court disqualification remains in place.

The Committee noted that Miss Barton did respond to the referral under Rule A12 to express mitigation

and contrition. However, the Committee deemed it proportionate to reflect and align with the court disqualification imposed.

Miss Barton stated that the offence occurred due to unplanned matings.

The Committee's view was that a breeder must take care to avoid unplanned matings.

If an unplanned mating has occurred, all breeders must take responsibility for meeting any legal or regulatory requirements as regards breeding on their premises.

After becoming aware of the first unplanned mating, Miss Barton could have approached the local authority and applied for the required licence. Miss Barton is an experienced breeder and failed to take the necessary actions.

The Committee's view is that it is a breeder's responsibility to ensure that they are fully informed about the breeding and licencing requirements – and seek help and advice if needed, perhaps from other breeders or sources of authority.

A breeder should be pro-active in this context.
