


## **Canine Body Condition Score questionnaire results**

circulated to the obedience community by June Le Fevre

The object of survey was to assess obesity within obedience dogs. We used the Purina Body Score system which rates the dogs out of 9. 1/9 would be considered severe malnutrition whilst 9/9 would be considered extremely obese with a risk to health. The optimum score for a working dog would be either 4.5/9 or 5/9.

Please note there was a total of 116 responses – which was quite low in my opinion. We always knew that there would be bias but obviously hoped that some contributors would be extremely honest about the condition of their dogs.


Please note that whilst there are also a lot of very fit dogs in obedience I do often see many that are more than the recommended body condition score.






Is your dog/bitch neutered?



What competition status is this dog? 116 responses




Do you train/compete in any other activities
